SVCE-Committees

Functions of various Committees:

- The following committees are functioning in the college to look after the administrative and academic procedures.
- These committees have been functioning in the college in order to facilitate the successful functioning.
- Each of the committees has been conducting its meetings and the minutes of which have been ratified from time to time.

Committees and its responsibilities

1. Finance & Purchase Committee (A. Krishna Mohan)

The Finance committee advises the governing Body on financial matters. They meet twice a year or as and when it is required.

The committee is responsible to

- Monitor budget requirements.
- Allocation of budget to various departments.
- Monitor financial outflow & to ensure improvements in financial practices.

2. R&D Cell Committee (Dr Kalesha Masthan Vali)

The committee is responsible to

- Scrutinize the research projects submitted by the faculty, and to recommend the deserving projects to the appropriate funding agencies for financial support
- Scrutinize the student’s project proposals to various agencies for financial support and recommend the suitable projects.
- Examine the applications received from the faculty members for sponsoring to higher education leading to the degrees M.Tech /MS/Ph.D.
- Examine the applications received from the faculty/students for patents/ awards and recommend to the appropriate authorities
- Examine the Research and consultancy projects and recommend the suitable projects to pursue.

3. Industry Institute Interaction Cell (K Upendra Raju)

- Enter into MOUs with industries, academic institutions and research organizations.
- Arrange for industrial visits and training facilities.
- Undertake industry related projects.
- Arrange for internships.
- Arrange seminars and workshops on industry needs.

4. Library Committee (Dr. K. Kumarswamy Reddy)

The committee is responsible to

- Maintenance of Digital Library and its usage.
- Subscribing for the new Journals and renewals for old journals.
- Purchase of text books, Reference Books, NPTEL and other learning material as per the requirement of the departments/ HOD's.

- Finalization of yearly budget, space and furniture requirements, Human resource requirement etc.
- Automation of library operations.

5. Anti Ragging Committee (Dr. N. Sudhakar Reddy & Dr. K. Sekar)

- Receiving complaints from freshers about ragging incidents. Enquiring and informing the authorities about the findings for appropriate action.

6. Grievance Redressal Committee (Dr. K Lokesh Krishna)
