**Need of the Activity:** To overcome the deaths caused by scarcity of blood and Appreciation of the institutions for their support.





Dear Colleague,

An efficient and effective national blood system mandates universal and timely access to safe blood. To ensure this, voluntary, non-remunerated, regular blood donation with wide and active participation of the people is required.

- 2: It is proposed to organize a mega blood donation camp on 17th September 2022. The Activity aims to collect close to one lakh units of blood from Voluntary blood donors on a single day. It is planned to involve all Ministries and Departments of Government of India, State/Union Governments, citizens of country, especially the youth various Non-Government and community based organizations and other stakeholders. The campaign slogan for the event will be "Donating blood is an act of solidarity. Join the effort and save lives." ["रक्तदान सामाजिक एकजुटता का प्रतीक है। प्रयास में सम्मिलित होकर जीवन बचाएं।"] States and Union Territories are requested to also organise their campaign in local/regional languages.
- 3. The States are requested to widely disseminate the information about the mega blood donation camp to be organized on 17th September 2022 to all medical colleges, hospitals, healthcare organizations, blood banks and other stake holders for their active participation. The blood banks in your State may be assisted to organize blood donation camps on 17-9-2022 and encouraged to collaborate with active and reputed NGOs promoting blood donation like Indian Red Cross Society, Akhil Bhartiya Terapanth Yuvak Parishad. Blood Danor Organizations etc. State Government Authorities including respective State AIDS Control Society (SACS), State Blood Transfusion Council (SBTC) may consider granting necessary permissions and facilitate organization of blood donation camps.
- 4. The facility for registration of voluntary blood donors is available on the Aarogya Setu App and e-Raktkosh portal of the Union Ministry of Health. A large scale media campaign for registering the pledges of persons on Aarogya Setu Apple-Raktkosh portal, for facilitating their blood donation in the identified blood banks/blood donation camps on 17th September, 2022 has been initiated by this Ministry.
- The Data of persons registered for blood donation on 17th September, 2022 on Aarogya Setu App, will be made accessible to blood banks/organizations conducting the blood donation camps through the e-RaktKosh web portal.
- After the mega blood donation camp on 17th September, 2022, the blood donation drive will be continued across all States / UTs till 01st October, 2022 i.e. National Voluntary Blood Donation Day (NVBDD).







### Attach Route Map of the Camp site from Dist / Mandal Head Quarters



really feels great to do positive for the nature.



- Under the guidance of the Principal, Dr N.Sudhkar Reddy, the camp was conducted by the VASAN Eye Care Hospital, Tirupati. The objective of the camp was to check the eyesight of the students and provide eye drops and suggest spectacles, which are environmentally friendly and fully biodegradable, to those who were found to have weak eyesight.
- The camp started at 10:30 AM and lasted till 4:00 PM for all the teachers, students and villagers. The eyesight of 40 students and nearly 62 villagers were tested in the presence of an ophthalmologist and optometrist. The parents of the students of Classes I-V were also present in the school while the tests were conducted.
- The eye tests were conducted in three stages and the students who were found to have weak eyesight were prescribed perfectly fitting spectacles with lenses as per their required powers. Moreover, each student was counseled by Dr S Masthan along with the parents regarding their eyesight and they were also advised about the importance of wearing spectacles on a regular basis to protect their precious eyes.
- The event was a fruitful one as many students benefited from the eye check-up and the timely intervention of the school helped them to focus on their studies in a better manner.

The event not only helped to prevent the further deterioration of the eyesight of the students but also provided a sense of relief to the parents.
