5. Summary of the event (Max. 1000 Words):

The DST-SERB sponsored a three day national level symposium on “NANOSTRUCTURED MATERIALS TO BATTERY AND SUPERCAPACITORS (NMBS-2023)” was organized by the department of Physics & Chemistry, Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering, Tirupati-517507 from 16<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> March 2023. This symposium brought together the leading industrialists, experts, and research scholars working in the field of energy storage devices such as batteries and supercapacitors to discover new products/ideas and create powerful solutions for the development of eco-friendly and safe futuristic devices. The programme enlightened the participants regarding the recent advances in the application of nanostructured materials to batteries and supercapacitors.

On the first day of the NMBS-2023 symposium, the registration process started at 9:15 AM, followed by the inauguration at 10:30 AM. The Chief Guest, Prof. Vijayamohan K Pillai, Chair of Chemistry and Dean of Research and Development at IISER Tirupati, delivered the keynote lecture on the demand for energy production and storage using nanostructured materials in the fourth-coming decade. Session 1 was conducted from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM, where Prof. Vijayamohan K Pillai gave a lecture on “Nanostructure Materials for Sustainable Energy Storage”.

Session 2, from 2:00 PM to 3:30 PM, included a lecture on “Nanostructured Materials for Energy Storage Applications” by Dr. D.H. Nagaraju, Professor, Department of Chemistry, REVA University, Bengaluru. Session 3, from 3:45 PM to 5:00 PM, Dr. D.H. Nagaraju continued and gave a talk on “Green synthesis of carbon-based materials to EDLC, Pseudocapacitor, Hybrid capacitor applications”. Overall, the first day of the symposium focused on the application of nanostructured materials in energy storage and featured lectures from prominent speakers in the field.

On Day 2 of the symposium, in the Session 4, Dr. D. Ebenezer, Manager R&D, from Amara Raja Batteries, Tirupati, spoke about battery safety measures and troubleshooting, covering topics such as identifying flaws in batteries, safety measures, and lithium-ion battery troubleshooting. In the Session 5, Dr. Ebenezer extended his talk on lithium-ion battery safety measures and common troubleshooting techniques. There was an interactive session with the participants followed by felicitation to Dr. D. Ebenezer. In the Session 6, Dr. D. Sridhar, Assistant Manager in R&D from Amara Raja Batteries, Tirupati, spoke about advancements in energy storage technologies, discussing the latest developments and innovations in lithium-ion batteries, lead-acid batteries, and advanced lead-acid batteries. He emphasized the need to improve energy density, cycle life, and safety, reduce costs and environmental impact. In Session 7, Dr. Sridhar highlighted the challenges and opportunities in the field and discussed the need for research on new materials, manufacturing processes, and recycling technologies. There was an interactive session with the participants and Dr. D. Sridhar was felicitated by the Principal.

On Day 3 of NMBS-2023, there were three sessions: Session 8 (9:30 AM-11:00 AM): Prof. G. Ranga Rao from IIT Madras delivered a talk on "Chalcogenide-based materials for electrochemical charge storage applications." The session focused on the use of chalcogenides in electrochemical energy storage devices. Session 9 (11:15 AM-1:00 PM): Prof. G. Ranga Rao continued his talk on chalcogenide-based materials and discussed recent advancements in the synthesis and characterization of these materials. The session also covered the performance of chalcogenides in different types of energy storage devices. Session 10 (2:00 PM-4:00 PM): Dr. Aravindan V from IISER, Tirupati delivered a talk on "Latest R&D Advancements in Supercapacitors." Dr. Aravindan discussed the current challenges in supercapacitor technology and highlighted the need for new materials and designs to overcome these challenges. He also covered the topic of lithium-ion battery recycling in his session.

The valedictory ceremony marked the end of the National Symposium on Nanostructured Materials to Battery and Supercapacitors (NMBS-2023), a three-day event that aimed to discuss the development of eco-friendly and economical devices with high safety and

efficiency. The speakers Prof. G. Ranga Rao from IIT Madras and Dr. Aravindan V from IISER Tirupati, and Dr. P. Babu, the convener of NMBS-2023, and Dr. K. Reddi Mohan Naidu, the co-convener were present in the valedictory ceremony. The participants were appreciated for their contributions, and certificates of participation were distributed. The vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. P. Geetha. The ceremony concluded with the national anthem.

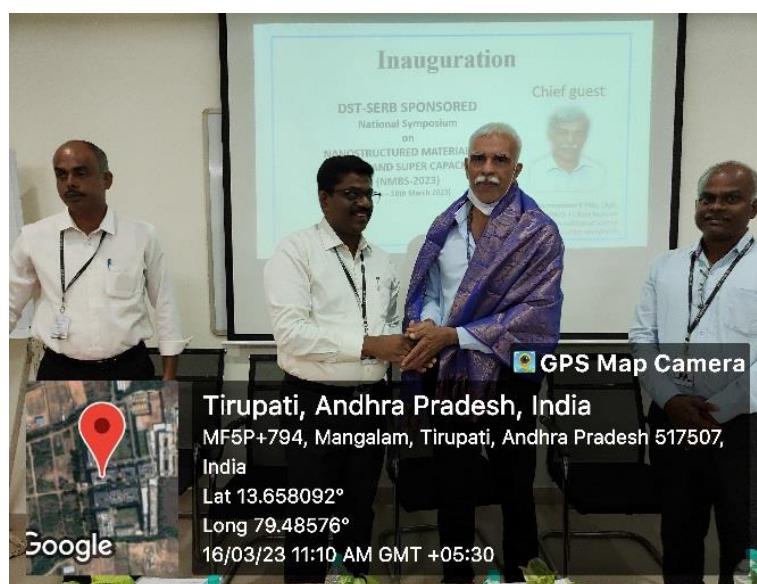

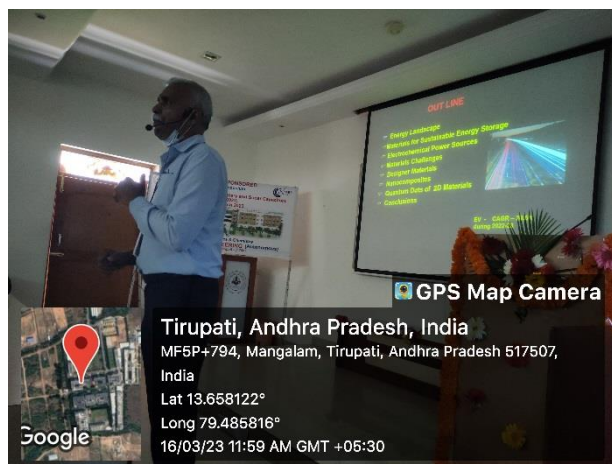

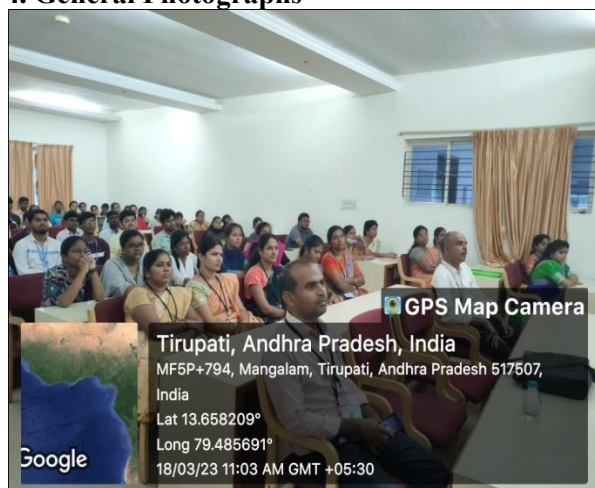

The following documents must be submitted to AICTE within a period of one month from the date of completion of project for reimbursement of the grant:


